Find Old Glory—Rules of the Game

To be eligible to play you must be 18 years of age or older, be a member of the American Legion family and have a valid picture ID.

Tickets will be sold at the American Legion Post 233 in Loganville until Friday 8:00PM.

Tickets are \$2.00 each and 6 for \$10.00 or 3 for \$5.00. There is no limit on the number of tickets purchased.

When the Old Glory is drawn prize money, the Jackpot, will be distributed as follows:

- 60% Old Glory Prize Value, known as the Jackpot
- 35% American Legion Post 233
- 5% Start of New Raffle

Consolation prizes will be awarded to present players as follows:

- State Flags \$25.00
- Service Flags \$50.00

The player must be present to claim the consolation prize.

Each player must write their full name and telephone number on each ticket. Only one name per ticket is allowed and it must be legible. In addition, the player may write their choice of card number (1-56) from the current selection of cards remaining on the board.

The winning ticket will be drawn at 8:30PM on Friday.

Once a ticket is drawn the player's name will be called out and they will have 3 (three) minutes to come to the board to select a card. A Raffle representative will verify the player's ID by comparing the name on the ticket and the player's picture ID. If these 2 (two) do not match the ticket will be considered invalid and a new ticket will be drawn. If the player is present and their ticket is valid they will be able to change their card number selection before drawing a card.

If a player fails to write down a card number, and they are not present, the first available card starting from number 1 will be selected for the player.

If Old Glory is drawn, and the player is present the player will receive the full amount of the Jackpot. If the player is not present they will receive half (50%) of the Jackpot. The remaining 50% will be used for the start of the new raffle.

All winners are responsible for the payment of any and all taxes. Upon the completion of IRS Form W-4 and submission of two forms of identification, one being a photo ID, all prizes will be paid by check to the winner on the following Monday. If the total winnings in a calendar year are \$600.00 or more, the appropriate W-2G or 1099-MISC will be issued.

Failure of the winner to return the proper paperwork and identification by 5:00pm the following Friday will void the prize money. Prize money will be added to the next week's jackpot.
